

Middle School Photography Summer Camp Open for Enrollment

Newburyport, Mass. -- The Rupert A. Nock Middle School, in collaboration with THEIA Studios, is offering a summer photography camp for middle school students only. The program, hosted at the Newburyport Art Association, offers a choice of two classes, including Photo Camp Week 1 and Photo Fusion Week 2. Students can attend both or either sessions, each of which will be offered twice throughout July, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.. Instruction will be led by longtime photographer and graphic designer Jodi Feil, who is a Northern Essex Community College photography instructor and co-founder of THEIA Studios, an education center for imaging arts in North Andover. Lori Muller, photographer and co-founder of THEIA Studios will lead instruction for the photo-fusion portion of the sessions.

The program will offer robust hands-on, photo-based art education in a fun and thought-provoking format using projects which focus on creativity as well as camera operation. In Photo Camp Week 1, students will learn composition as well as quick functions to change exposure, motion and mood and the mechanics of shooting with different camera types such as DSLR, iPhone and Holga cameras. Photo Fusion Camp Week 2 will introduce further photography skills and incorporate videography capabilities of digital devices. Students will create an iMovie using still and moving images. Camps can be taken progressively or independently and will include outdoor photo shoots within walking distance from the Newburyport Art Association where students can practice what they learn. Students must bring their own camera. DSLR, iPhone or point-and-shoot cameras are welcome and THEIA Studios will provide Holga cameras for student use.

Photo Camp Week 1 is scheduled the weeks of July 7 and July 21.
Photo Fusion Week 2 is scheduled the weeks of July 14 and July 28. The cost of each week is \$425 or two weeks for \$800.
Priority registration is open for Nock Middle School students only through June 2nd and will open to all middle school students who are residents of Newburyport beginning June 3rd.

Classes are limited to 12 students. Middle School students include students entering grades 6, 7 or 8.
