Girls Inc. of the Seacoast Area whose mission is to inspire all girls to be strong, smart and bold is leading E3 – Exploring Entrepreneurial Experiences at the Nock for middle school girls after school free of charge. This is a fun, hands-on program in the area of economic literacy. Girls have the opportunity to think creatively and gain confidence.

The key messages of E3 are:

1. Entrepreneurs are ordinary people like all of us who start and run their own businesses.
2. Starting a business of your own is an option worth considering.
3. Many people, including people your age, sell goods or services to make money.
4. Successful businesses start with a plan.
5. How much you charge for your goods and services depends on how much they cost to make or do and how much others are willing to pay.
6. A healthy business changes as it grows. Failure is often part of growth.

Attendance at all sessions is important both for the individual girls as well as for the group and is therefore mandatory unless a girl is absent from school.

We meet on Mondays from 2:10-3:10 starting January 27 and ending March 24. One session will be a fun field trip to visit women-owned businesses in downtown Newburyport.

To participate in E3, girls sign up with Ms. Furlong and must give her the permission slip before the first session.
