



School Year 2014/2015 Grade 6 Recommended Supplies

The 6th grade teachers have created a supply list of materials that will assist each student in establishing a system of routines and organizational strategies. Although we know this list works for most students, we do realize that modifications may need to be made to support individual strategies and needs. We are hoping that students will be able to set some foundational structures this year that will assist them in their future years of learning here at the Nock Middle School.

- **Pencils and erasers** (2 boxes of 12 minimum to start the year) & **Eraser Caps**

*** In an effort to improve organization for our students, we are asking for the following supplies in the suggested colors:**

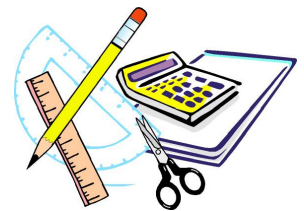
- 1 1/2 inch binder, **BLUE**, for Math, with 5 dividers
 - 1 single subject spiral notebook that fits into a binder
- 1 inch binder, **GREEN**, for Social Studies, with 3 dividers
- 1 inch binder, **BLACK**, for Science, with 5 dividers
- 1 inch binder, **CRIMSON**, for Language Arts, with 2 dividers
 - 1 composition notebook that fits into a binder

**** All of the dividers should be the “write on” style**
