

DC DOLLARS

“DC Dollars” is the name we’ve given to an incredibly easy-to-use fundraising program that allows Nock families to raise money for their child’s eighth grade fieldtrip to Washington DC. The website we use for this fundraiser is officially called “Shop with Scrip” and it is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash and credit cards. Each gift card offers a different rebate amount. For example, an iTunes gift card earns a 5% rebate, Macy’s offers a 10% rebate, and LL Bean earns a 17% rebate! Most of your favorite retailers participate in Shop with Scrip. The rebates you earn are then automatically applied to help pay off the balance due on your child’s DC trip.

For the summer months and beyond, we are offering parents the opportunity to purchase e-gift certificates that can be printed out at home enabling you to make last minute purchases while still taking advantage of this great fundraising tool. This means that you can purchase a Walmart or Staples gift card to purchase back to school supplies, print it out at home, and then receive a rebate which will be automatically credited to your child’s DC account. Your family and friends can also sign up and earn rebates for your child’s account.



How to Start Earning DC Dollars

- ➔ Go to shopwithscrip.com.
- ➔ Create Account.
- ➔ Enter the following enrollment code: **BEE4C32213L34**
- ➔ Click on the “Shop” tab at the top to browse gift card selection.
- ➔ Click on the “ScripNow” icon located directly under the “Shop” tab.
- ➔ If you purchase any gift cards, be sure to go to your shopping cart and click “CHECKOUT”. If you do not “CHECKOUT”, then the order will not be placed.
- ➔ When checking out, be sure to use Presto Pay to pay for your order. No payments by check will be accepted over the summer and orders that are submitted to be paid by check will not be filled.
- ➔ Print out your gift card and start shopping!
