

## Clothing/Equipment List: 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Camp Kieve

### **CLOTHING SHOULD BE MAINE WEATHER APPROPRIATE**

- Sleeping bag or 3 blankets & 2 sheets
  - Pillow
  - Clothing enough for the week, weather appropriate
  - Rain gear
  - Cold weather gear: hats, gloves, scarves
  - Boots/hiking shoes & extra sneakers (closed toe shoes)
  - Toiletry items – tooth paste, tooth brush, soap, shampoo, chapstick, deodorant, sunscreen, bug repellent (no aerosol)
  - 2 towels
  - Flashlight
  - Plenty of socks
  - White or light colored T shirt for tie dying
  - Heavy sweater/sweatshirt and Heavy jacket
  - Lightweight jacket or fleece
  - Camera (if you have one; disposable ones are great)
  - Water bottle (optional)
  - Stamped envelopes and writing paper
  - Laundry bag
- Ipods & e-readers are allowed, but may not leave the child's cabin unless for medical reasons
  - Ipods & e-readers are allowed on the bus rides to and from Kieve
  - **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:** cell phones, dvd players, jackknives, candy, gum, food

**ALL medications (over the counter, vitamins and Rx) must be in original container with only the amount for the 5 days, LABELED with child's name and in a ziplock bag. ALL medications (over the counter, vitamins and Rx) must be checked in at school when the student is checked in on Tuesday morning. All medications will be available for PARENT pick up upon arrival at school on Friday afternoon.**
