The time is just about here for our 6th graders to leave for *Camp Kieve* in Nobleboro, ME. **Please take the time to carefully read over the following last instructions to enable us to have a smooth and prompt departure on Wednesday, May 18, 2016**

Check-in and Departure Information:

PLEASE ENTER THE SCHOOL THROUGH THE DOORS AT THE GYM/SUPERINTENDENT'S OFFICE FROM THE SIDE PARKING LOT.

Student check-in will begin promptly at 6:45. Students should report to the hallway outside of the gym, where they will line up by team. Students will be checked in and ALL medications collected. Students will not be allowed to keep any medications with them or in their cabin. All prescription & non-prescription medications must be in their original containers and clearly labeled with the child's name and directions for use. Blank medication forms will be available if changes/updates need to be made. After check-in, students will report to the gym where they will be grouped by their assigned bus. Departure from school is planned for 7:30am.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **We should already have a medication administration form for any medications your child is now taking. If he/she is taking additional or different medication or no longer taking a medication at the time we leave, please fill out a new form. These forms will be available at the time of check in.**

Suggested Clothing & Equipment List –

- Luggage should be limited to one piece; a duffel bag, if available, is ideal.
- Students will be allowed to have IPODS on the bus; Please, No Cell Phones
- An additional copy of this list is enclosed with this letter. This is just a "suggested" list. When packing please keep the existing or forecasted weather conditions FOR MAINE in mind. We suggest packing this list with your child's clothing to be used as a check off list when he/she packs to return.
- **Please label all clothing and items carefully.** Every year there are numerous unclaimed items that we are unable to return to the owners because they are not labeled. Please claim lost items as soon as possible upon your child's return. Lost & found will be in the 6th grade classroom area.

Return Information: ALL students will be returning to school by bus.

Our anticipated arrival at the RAN MIDDLE SCHOOL IN NEWBURYPORT on Friday, May 20, 2016 is approximately 2:30-3:00pm. Buses will unload in the side parking lot.

Please park in the side parking lot, so as not to create a traffic hazard on Low St. Thank you for your cooperation.

PLEASE SEE THE NURSE ON FRIDAY AT PICKUP TO RETRIEVE YOUR CHILD'S MEDICATIONS.

NEW INFORMATION REGARDING LETTERS FROM HOME

This is a reminder that mail will be most appreciated by your child. However, due to our shortened stay at Kieve, there will be a letter collection box here at school at check-in. Letters will be distributed to the students during their stay at Kieve.

CLOTHING SHOULD BE MAINE WEATHER APPROPRIATE

It is **NOT** necessary to purchase new clothing, bedding or luggage

Please contact the school if you are in need of any of the items on the list.

- Sleeping bag or 3 blankets & 2 sheets
- Pillow
- Clothing enough for the week, weather appropriate
- Rain gear
- Cold weather gear: hats, gloves, scarves
- Boots/hiking shoes & extra sneakers (closed toe shoes)
- Toiletry items – tooth paste, tooth brush, soap, shampoo, chapstick, deodorant, sunscreen, bug repellent (no aerosol)
- 2 towels
- Flashlight
- Plenty of socks
- White or light colored T shirt for tie dying (optional)
- Heavy sweater/sweatshirt and Heavy jacket
- Lightweight jacket or fleece
- Camera (if you have one; disposable ones are great)
- Water bottle (optional)
- Stamped envelopes and writing paper
- Laundry bag

- Ipods & e-readers are allowed on the bus rides to and from Kieve (NO PHONES)
- Camp Staff will collect and store Electronic devices in a locked closet in your child's cabin

- **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:** cell phones, dvd players, jackknives, candy, gum, food

ALL medications (over the counter, vitamins and Rx) must be in original container with only the amount for the 3 days, **LABELED** with your child's name and in a ziplock bag. **ALL** medications (over the counter, vitamins and Rx) must be checked in at school when the student is checked in on Wednesday morning. All medications will be available for **PARENT** pick up upon arrival at school on Friday afternoon.
